

NPWC College Matching Scholarships

Mission Statement

To promote the attendance of our youth and adults at Wesleyan denominational colleges and other Christian institutions of higher education whose doctrines reflect the same basic Christian beliefs as the Wesleyan Church.

Funding

1. Monies for the College Matching Scholarship Fund (CMSF) will come from gifts and contributions and will not be considered part of the church budget. However, gifts may be given to the CMSF from the church budget as determined by the Local Church Conference.
2. All gifts and contributions are to be given to the CMSF and not to any individual.
3. Gifts and contributions for the CMSF should be made payable to the church and designated for the CMSF and receipts will be issued for the calendar year.

Eligibility Criteria

1. The applicant must be a regular attendee of North Park Wesleyan Church for at least one year prior to the first year of receiving the matching scholarship and continue the home church relationship with North Park Wesleyan Church when dwelling in the church's service area.
2. The person must submit an application for the matching scholarship to the church by April 1st of each year.
3. Verification of acceptance by an approved Christian college is required at the time of submission of the application.
4. To receive the educational grant in the fall, the student must be a full-time matriculated student carrying at least 12 credit hours of course work.
5. The student must maintain a GPA of at least 2.0 in a 4-point system in subsequent years that the matching scholarship is requested.

Matching Scholarships

1. The size of the individual scholarships will be dependent upon the size of the CMSF on June 1st of each year. All scholarships awarded in a given academic year will be of equal size.
2. The scholarship will be awarded on a yearly basis in the fall of the academic year.
3. Scholarships will be co-paid to the educational institution and the student in accordance with the school's financial policies and mailed directly to the school.
