

MEALS OF LOVE POLICY & PROCEDURE

1. The Church Office is responsible for enlisting attendees to sign up on the Meal Train website to provide a meal or meals as needed for any individual or family suffering a severe illness and/or recovering from significant surgery. (Length of time for meals as well as what is considered “severe” or “significant” will be determined by the office based on circumstances and taking into account requests from the individual or family.)
2. The Office will contact the individual or family to find out if they would like meals supplied, any likes or dislikes, and any allergies.
3. Meals will be taken to the home or an agreed upon meeting place by the person supplying the meal at a time the individual or family chooses as convenient.
4. The Office will confirm with the individual or family what time they would like to receive meals and inform those who are supplying meals.
5. The Meal Train schedule of meals will be shared with the individual or family so they are aware of who they will be meeting with.
6. There is also an option on the Meal Train website to purchase gift cards for restaurants or delivery services so the individual or family can choose a meal themselves.
7. A link to the meal train and all details of the need will be posted by the office on both North Park’s website and Facebook page.
