The "Mission House" is available as a welcome home spot for missionaries and those individuals meeting criteria for temporary house as established by the Local Board of Administration.

House availability:

1. Missionaries – needing a home while traveling or on furlough.
2. Guest – speakers, staff, or NP members and their family.
3. Others – those approved by the Mission Team.
4. Non-missionaries staying over 10 days need LBA approval.

NPWC's Mission House provides a place for God's kingdom people. We do this out of kindness and because we sense a need. We are blessed to have this house to be used as the need arises.

The parties involved will sign an agreement.

A beginning and ending dates are defined.

The members occupying the house will keep a clean and sanitary house, removing the trash to a can provided near the garage and placing at the curb on Tue. evening for Wed am pick-up.

Tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs, smoking, and illegal activity are prohibited.

Occupants will be held responsible for damage caused to the property.

Noise will be kept to a reasonable level.

No animals or pets may be on the premises without permission.

Occupants will notify the Mission Director (Mary Enos – 585-968-8803) or Facility Chair (Scott Card – 716-378-6980) or Church Office (585-968-2347) of any problems or issues.

The house is furnished. The occupants may use any appliance or supplies while at the house.
