

Nursery Policy and Procedures

North Park Wesleyan Church loves ALL of God's children. It is because of this that North Park is committed to running a quality Nursery Ministry so that the parents can be free to worship and the children can experience Christ's love through His Church. We can accomplish this together by focusing on Safety, Cleanliness and Comfort.

- The Nursery is for children aged Birth – 3 years ONLY. Children will be placed in the appropriate nursery for their age: 0-18 months in the infant nursery; and 18 months – 3 years in the Toddlers Nursery.
- Each child will need to be signed in and out by their parent (caregiver). They will receive a card which corresponds to their child, and only their child. Their child will be entrusted back to their care upon receipt of the appropriately numbered card. The child will then have a self-adhesive label placed on their back with that child's name written on it by the nursery staff. This will aid the staff in knowing the names of all the children, as well as make the children feel more comfortable because they are known.
- Upon signing in their child, all diaper bags and bottles will need to be labeled by the parent (caregiver) to avoid accidental mix-ups.
- Nursery staff will need to arrive in the Nursery no later than 10 minutes prior to the service; and parents (caregivers) will need to pick up their children as soon as feasible upon the completion of the service.
- If the parent (caregiver) is needed for whatever reason; an extra nursery staff person or an usher will discreetly advise them of the situation as soon as possible.
- For the health of the other children, the nursery staff and the comfort of each child; only healthy children (and staff) may utilize the Nursery Ministry. For clarity's sake, please do not use the Nursery Ministry if your child has:
 - Runny Nose
 - Fever
 - Flushed Cheeks
 - Excessive Coughing
 - Vomitted within the last 24 hours
- Nursery staff will follow all posted cleanliness guidelines. Parents and staff, please familiarize yourself with said guidelines.
